Our goal is to transform Students into responsible citizens of the World, who are - healthy, sharp and spiritually elevated.



- Workshop on Sahaj Yoga meditation for staff on college level












#### Role, Responsibility and Function Of Sports Committee

- 1) To organize sports for everybody in the institute so they can learn themselves to keep physically fit.
- 2) To enhance the interest of the students in sports.
- For this enhancement use various methods like training, coaching, organizing sports also motivate students to participate in different sports event outside the institute.
- 4) Making teams for various sports by proper selection, Coaching and training so that institute can participate in different sports event at state level, University level, National level and international level.
- Give support to students for all facilities of indoor, outdoor sports.
- 6) Provide all types of sports equipment as per requirement of students.
- Arrange Fit India sports program , Yoga , Sports day for students as well as for faculties and staff.
- Budget management, reviewing account monthly, keeping records of sports achievement as well as records of spending budget.



#### SOP - SELECTION PROCESS FOR ALL SPORTS ACTIVITY

#### Orientation -

Carrying out Orientation for all sports activities is a regular process of sports department.

Sports director briefs about various sports events and activities carried and also describes about the achievements of students to encourage and motivate new comers for participation in their respective sports.

Sports director also highlight various facilities given by the college for sports like travel arrangement, food at the time of event, free registration for events, required equipment purchasing process etc.

#### Selection Process -

After orientations session, students have to fill one google form to register for various sports activities or they can enrolled their names directly in registration book after discussion with sports director.

List of various sports activity is made accordingly based on registration count.

e.g. 50 students enrolled for basketball they are all called on particular day along with senior players. Selection process is taken by using particular sports batteries. A small match is also taken as a part of process. Additional 10 players were identified and selected in squad for college team as a backup. Those who remains absent due to some reason, one chance is given to them and all of them will be tested with squad to prove their place. Above mentioned process is almost similar for all sports. All selections take place in presence of sports director, sports assistant & senior experienced player of particular sports (either captain or vice-captain).

#### Various Sports Batteries Test -

There are various sports batteries for various sports. In that we can test skill Power, strength, agility of the player.

For example basketball sports skill test - Dribbling with ball, two minutes shooting with basketball standing under the ring and make a proper shoot in the ring and that shoot get counted etc.

50 meter run is test is important to get the speed of the player standing broad jump is important to know the strength of the legs of player like that pushup and pull ups are also important to know the explosive power of hands ,etc.










National Level Chess Championship Certificate of Chess Team (2020-21)





Silver Medal in National Level Chess Event (2020-21)










