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Evaluation Scheme for Academic Year 2024-2025

In AY 2024-2025 there are three examination Patterns are in run as mentioned below:

Evaluation Process: The evaluation is as follows:

1. Mid Semester Examination (Th.- MSE)

This examination shall be conducted centrally in the scheduled week approximately six weeks after commencement of the semester.

2. End Semester Examination (Th.- ESE)

The End Semester examination shall be conducted after completion of the semester for which the dates are given in the Academic Calendar.

A. The separate passing system will be followed for the current academic year for Regular Students.

- i) The students of the <u>fourth year</u> (2019 Pattern) will be declared passed if they score a minimum of 40 percent marks separately in the Internal Assessment (IA) head and 40 percent in the theory exam head (MSE + ESE).
- ii) For the First, second and third year (2022 and 2023 NEP Pattern) students has to score minimum of;

- 40 percent in IA &
- 40 percent in (IA +MSE) and ESE separately to earn a passing grade.
- B. The combined passing system (IA+MSE+ESE) will be followed for the current academic year for Backlog students.

3. Practical Examination (PR./PROJECT/Internship/Skill Lab)

A. <u>The separate passing system will be followed for the current academic year for</u> <u>Regular Students</u>

For Regular Students **PR./PROJECT/Internship/Skill Lab** heads, students will have to score 40 % of marks in the <u>Continuous Assessment</u> as well as <u>Final</u> <u>Practical</u>, <u>PROJECT/Internship/Skill Lab</u> <u>Examination</u> component independently.

B. <u>The combined passing system (CA+PR) will be followed for the current</u> <u>academic year for Backlog students.</u>

For Backlog Students **PR./PROJECT/Internship/Skill Lab** heads, students will have to score 40 % of marks in the <u>Continuous Assessment</u> and <u>Final Practical</u>, <u>PROJECT/Internship/Skill Lab Examination</u> component combinedly.

As per pattern/s of examination the Evaluation Scheme for the academic year 2024-25 is as below:

1. Evaluation Scheme (2019 Pattern Regular and Backlog)

A. Theory Course:

There will be a **30(IA): 70(MSE+ESE) pattern** for the evaluation of each theory course.

B. Lab Course

- i) There will be a **20(CA): 30(PR) pattern** for the evaluation of each <u>1 Credit Lab</u> <u>course.</u>
- ii) There will be a **35(CA): 40(PR) pattern** for the evaluation of each <u>2 Credit Lab</u> <u>course.</u>
- 2. Evaluation Scheme (2022 and 2023 NEP Pattern Regular and Backlog)

A. Theory Course:

There will be a **30(IA)+20(MSE) : 50(ESE) pattern** for the evaluation of each theory course.

B. Lab Course

i) There will be a **20(CA): 30(PR) pattern** for the evaluation of each <u>1 Credit Lab</u> <u>course.</u>

ii) There will be a **35(CA): 40(PR) pattern** for the evaluation of each <u>2 Credit Lab</u> <u>course.</u>

Syllabus for Theory Examination:

- 1. 2019 Pattern Regular and Backlog
 - A. **Mid semester examination** The Examination will be based on first Three units of the course. The MSE will be conducted offline. The examination will be of 50 marks.
 - B. End Semester examination The Examination will be based on last Three units of the course. Examination will be conducted at the end of the semester and will be conducted offline mode. The examination will be conducted for 50 marks.
- 2. 2022 and 2023 NEP Pattern Regular and Backlog
 - A. Mid semester examination 20 marks weightage based on two units of the course, The MSE will be conducted offline. The examination will be of 20 marks.
 - B. End Semester examination 50 marks weightage-based on all units of the course. Examination will be conducted at the end of the semester and will be conducted offline/ physical mode. The examination will be conducted for 50 marks

Detention policy:

The detention will be based on

- i) non fulfilment of 75 percent attendance in each course
- ii) non completion of IA i.e. scoring less than forty percent marks in the internal assessment.

Promotion Criteria - in order to be promoted to the higher class (year) each student will have to earn 50 % credits of the previous year and 100 % credits of the preprevious year. The students who do not fulfil the above-mentioned criteria will not be permitted to take admission to the higher class and will consequently lose one academic year.

To illustrate: a student will be promoted to third year only if he / she has earned 50 % credits of SYBTECH and 100 % credits of FYBTECH, similarly to be promoted to final year BTECH a student must have earned at least 50% credits of TYBTECH and 100 % credits of SYBTECH.

Backlog-examination for both the semesters of the academic year 2024-25 will be conducted at the end of the Even Semester, after the ESE of Even semester- in the

<u>month of May/June/July 2025</u>. The **Backlog Examination** will be of 70 marks for Final Year B Tech students and will be of 50 marks for First, Second- and Third-Year B Tech students. The scores of the Internal Assessment (IA) will be carried forward. The pattern of examination will remain 30: 70 i.e. 30 marks for IA +MSE (carried forward) & 50 marks for Theory examination based on <u>whole syllabus</u>.
