- d) IQAC has played an important role to implement NAAC Peer Team recommendations.
- e) IQAC ensures maximum utilization of infrastructural facilities and the available ICT resources
- f) The institution has an active Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) to frame the policy for the administrative growth of the institution.
- g) Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) of the College based on the quality parameters/assessment criteria developed by the relevant quality assurance body like NAAC, NBA, in the prescribed format.
- h) Preparation and submission of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) as per guidelines and parameters of NAAC.
