

Rules and Regulations for Event

- Registration Fee for Individual 25/- for group of 2 50/-
- Participants need to register through the link and pay the registration fee on the given account and upload the payment screenshot in the given registration form.
- Every group will get a maximum of 3 min to present their idea.
- The idea should be unique and innovative, if the idea is copied then the team/ participant will be disqualifies
- The Idea should fulfill the criteria of zero investment.
- The idea can also be presented as a draft in form of proper documentation or also through a short video)
- The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Only one entry will be accepted per person/group.
- A person can be in only one group.
- The deadline for receiving entries for the competition is final. No entries received after the given date will be considered.
